Reading

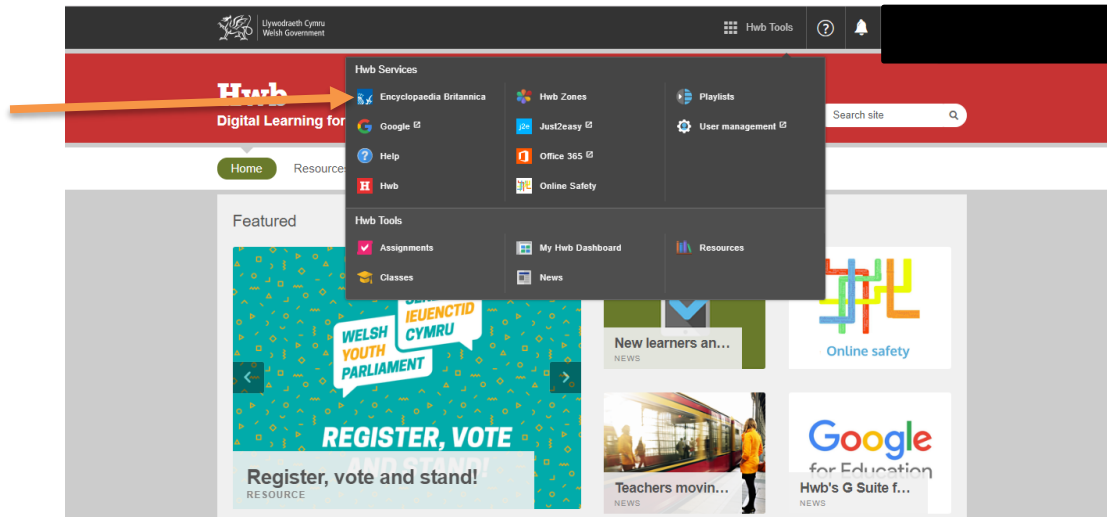

Literacy
