Because – **B**ig **e**lephants **c**an **a**lways **u**nderstand **s**mall **e**lephants

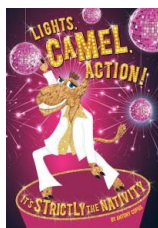

Maths

This week in Maths the pupils have been again working hard on multiplication. This week's Home Learning focuses on the using the x3 tables to find the x6 table by doubling. The children can complete the sums in their Home Learning book. The first question has been done for the pupils as an example.

1) $3 \times 3 = 9$ **so** $3 \times 6 = 18$

2) $5 \times 3 =$ **so** $5 \times 6 =$

3) $1 \times 3 =$ **so** $1 \times 6 =$

4) $4 \times 3 =$ **so** $4 \times 6 =$

5) $7 \times 3 =$ **so** $7 \times 6 =$

6) $2 \times 3 =$ **so** $2 \times 6 =$

7) $6 \times 3 =$ **so** $6 \times 6 =$

8) $9 \times 3 =$ **so** $9 \times 6 =$

9) $8 \times 3 =$ **so** $8 \times 6 =$

10) $10 \times 3 =$ **so** $10 \times 6 =$
