Maths

This week in Maths the pupils have been working hard on subtraction. This week's Home Learning is focusing upon using written methods of subtraction. The children can subtract using the compact method with exchange (borrowing). If the number the children are subtracting from is smaller than the number they are subtracting, children will have to borrow from the next column.

Please can the children copy and complete the sums in their Home Learning book. The first question has been done for the pupils as an example. If children are finding the subtraction sums difficult, they can use the 100 square below to help them.

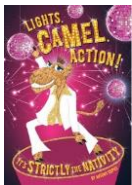
