#### Hwb

In KS2 this week we have continued to use Hwb to support our learning. Our focus has been on three areas of Hwb: j2e Times Table Blast, j2e Spell Blaster and j2e Cargo Bridge. As part of home learning we would like the children to log into Hwb using their usernames and passwords. If your child is having trouble logging into Hwb please let your child's class teacher know. Any device can be used to access Hwb including desktop computers, laptops, tablets or even mobile phones. Once in Hwb we would like the children to navigate to the 'j2e' section of Hwb (Hwb Tools -> just2easy) and undertake the following activities:

- → **SpellBlaster:** Allows children to practise and then test their spelling knowledge.
- → ttblast: Allows children to practise and then test their times tables knowledge.
- → Cargo Bridge: Allows children to build a series of bridges from one side of a valley to another. Children will need to search for this activity in the search box.
